FEE SCHEDULE¹

| SERVICE | FEE ² |
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| A. PATENTS: | |
| 1. Preparation of typical UTILITY PATENT application | \$3,500 - \$5,500 (approximate range) billed hourly including filing fee (around \$545) and two drawing sheets (\$250); ³ office actions billed separately, and in addition to the foregoing range. Written flat fee quotes available on request. |
| 2. Preparation of a DESIGN PATENT | \$1,600 flat fee including filing fee (around \$230) and two drawing sheets (\$250); office actions billed separately. |
| 3. Preparation of a PROVISIONAL PATENT application | \$2,500 (including \$200 filing fee) minimum flat fee plus additional fees if greater than five hours are required to prepare and file application. A provisional application is a temporary measure. I generally recommend filing a regular utility patent application. You should plan on subsequently filing a utility application, which must be filed within one year. |
| 4. PATENT SEARCH and novelty letter | \$600 flat fee including applicable fees and costs, if any; the entire fee is due when client elects to proceed with search. |
| B. TRADEMARKS: | |
| Preparation of a typical trademark application: | \$600 plus filing fee (\$325 per class per mark for TEAS applications). Additional work billed hourly. Expect that at least one response to office action will be required about 6 - 12 months after filing. Responses to office action typically take from 2 - 6 hours. |
| C. COPYRIGHTS: | |
| Preparation of a typical copyright application | \$200 plus filing fee (\$45); responses to one office action included, additional work billed hourly. |
| D. LITIGATION / MISCELLANEOUS: | |
| Litigation / Document Drafting / Miscellaneous | Litigation and miscellaneous work is billed at an hourly rate of \$350. Bills are prepared monthly unless other arrangements are made. A \$2,500.00 retainer and a minimum balance on deposit will be required for most work. |

¹The fees in this schedule may be changed without notice, and no contract will be formed for representation except as confirmed in writing by the Firm. Payments are due when billed, unless other written arrangements are made, and interest will accrue on past due payments from the date they are late until paid in full at a rate of 2% per month. For customers paying with a credit card, charges will be billed to that card after 7 days from the date of mailing the invoice.

² For flat fee services (except searches), ½ of the fee is due when client elects to proceed, and the second ½ is due when the work is complete (e.g., the application is ready to be filed). The first ½ of the fee is non-refundable. Unless otherwise specifically noted, responses to office actions and other work subsequent to preparation of application will be billed hourly in addition to specified flat fee amounts. Flat fee work also subject to limitation that revisions suggested or directed by client must be reasonable; Firm reserves the right to assess hourly charges for excessive revisions.

³ Many, if not most, patents require more than two drawing sheets. For applications where more than two drawing sheets are needed, the costs associated with preparation of formal drawing sheets will be higher, likely pushing the total cost of the patent higher than the specified approximate range.
